**ORDINANCE NO. 37-26**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE SANITARY BOARD OF THE  
ORO LOMA SANITARY DISTRICT  
ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR SERVICES AND  
FACILITIES FURNISHED BY THE DISTRICT'S  
SANITARY SEWAGE SYSTEM AND PROVIDING COLLECTION  
PROCEDURES AND PENALTIES FOR ENFORCEMENT**

At the regular meeting of the Sanitary Board of the Oro Loma Sanitary District, held June 3, 2008, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 37-26, which establishes charges for services and facilities furnished by the District's sanitary sewage system. Changes to this ordinance are comprised of a reduction in rates for residential dwellings; all other rates and charges remain the same. The changes to the Ordinance are summarized as follows:

Section 22, "**Effective Date**": new effective date set as July 1, 2008.

Exhibit A, "**Sewer Service Charge Rates**": Reduction in the sewer service rates for Residential Single Family Dwellings from \$193 per year to \$178; reduction in Multiple Family Dwellings from \$178.78 per year to \$178; reduction in Mobile Homes/House Trailers from \$146.58 per year to \$145; and, a reduction in the annual minimum sewer service charge from \$146.58 to \$145.
